

La Trappe Trappist Brewery

- BREWERY HISTORY - In 1880 the Abbot Dominicus Lacaes of the Trappist monastery Saint Marie du Mont, Northern France, was worried about the fate of his monks. At this time things were not looking up for religious life in France as a result of the church legislation, monasteries were threatened in their existence. One Monk from Saint Marie was sent to seek refuge, he found in the Netherlands what is now known today as the La Trappe Brewery, with many more monks seeking refuge, farming the land alone was not enough to sustain so many monks and it was decided that one monk would travel to Munich to learn the brewing process thus the brewery was born. Over the years there have been a few take over's but in 1980 the friars decided to take back control and this was when the name La Trappe was given.
